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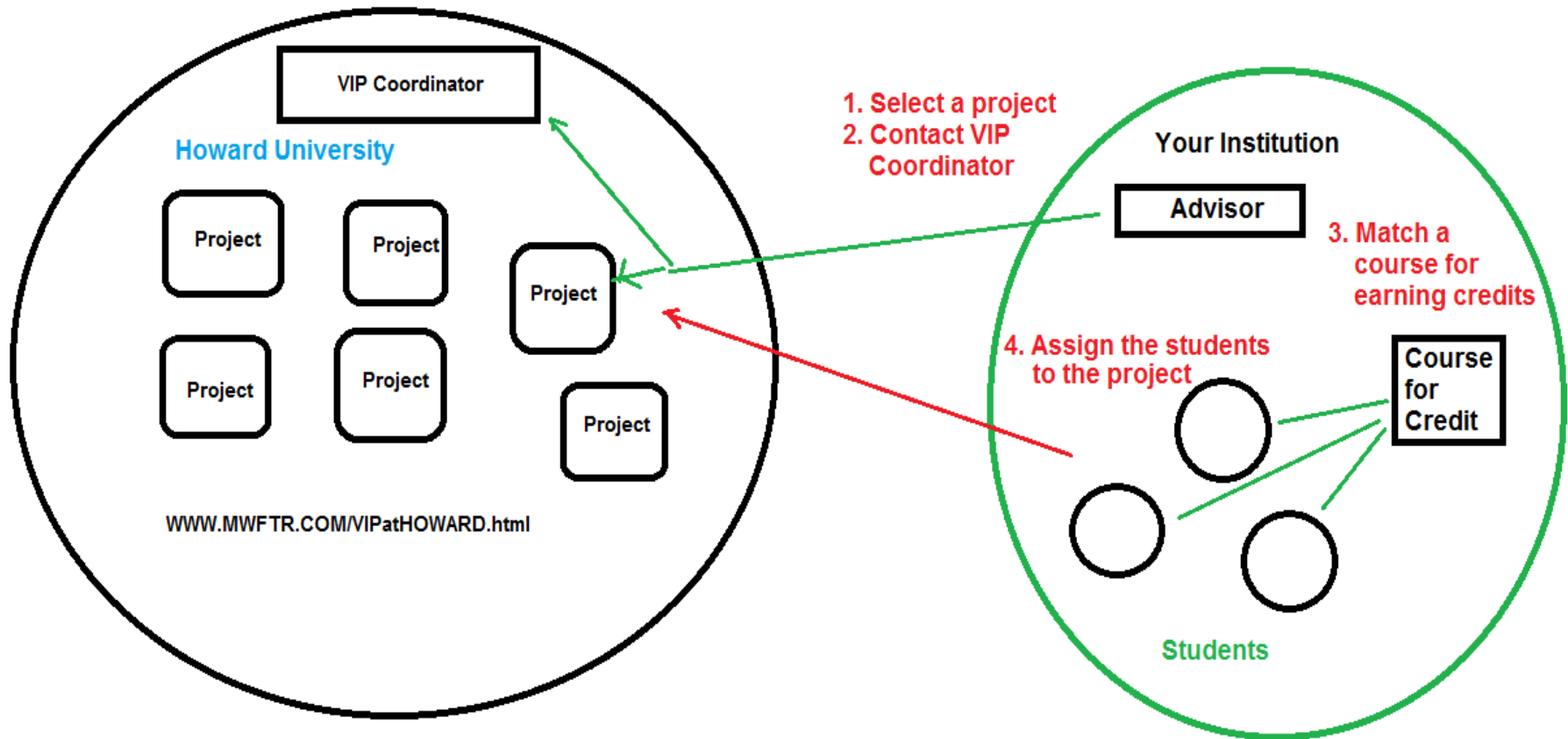

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# How Inter-Collegiate VIP Program works

- Model
  - A student at a Non-VIP institution takes a (substitutable) course in his/her own university.
  - The student, by his/her advisor's suggestion, selects a team of the Howard University's VIP projects.
  - The student participates with the team members in person or remotely.
  - The student will be evaluated by the team members, the VIP team faculty advisor, and the VIP coordinator.
  - The evaluation result will be provided to the student's course instructor/advisor of his/her institution,
  - The student receives a grade from the instructor assigned to the course of his/her institution.

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# How to join VIP Teams at Howard

- By Non-VIP Institution faculty Initiation
  - Check the website: [www.mwftr.com/VIPatHOWARD.html](http://www.mwftr.com/VIPatHOWARD.html)
  - Select a team project
  - Decide/select students who want to join the teams
  - Find a course (of their department) for giving credit to the students for participating in the team project
  - The students will do team work, and will be evaluated by the team (peer evaluation), the team advisor, and the VIP coordinator
